Item No 1: To consider report of the Vice Chancellor about the developments since the last Court Meeting held on 15th April, 2013.

During the period under report emphasis remained on strengthening of already existing Post Graduate programmes, introduction of four new Research Degree programmes, accomplishment of admission process, recruitment of faculty and non-teaching staff and initiatives for providing infrastructure at Temporary Academic Block, besides development of allotted site of the University Campus at Village Bagla, District Samba.

In order to integrate academic activities at one place for the best utilization of resources, two Academic Programmes being conducted at Temporary Academic Block I, on Jammu Bye-Pass Road, from where the University initially started its functioning, were shifted to Temporary Academic Block at Sainik Colony, Jammu. Creation of additional accommodation was ensured and infrastructure put in place for accommodating the Departments of English and Educational Studies in the newly constructed space during the months from May to July 2013. This has helped the University to rationalize on the logistics and management of limited human resource in the initial years of establishment.

Apart from this, activities related to admission involving data processing, conduct of Entrance Examination, compiling of merit and admission of students in the respective departments were undertaken simultaneously.

Concurrently attention was focussed on issues related to possession of allotted land and Campus development, including initiation of construction activities by the Architect, PMC and the contractor.

Details of various initiatives / steps undertaken are enumerated as follows for perusal of worthy members of the Court.

Admissions

The University initiated the process for admissions in March, 2013 for eight Post Graduate Programmes in the subjects of Economics, Master of Education (M.Ed.), Computer Science, Environmental Sciences, Applied Mathematics, English & Comparative Literature, MBA Tourism and Travel Management, and MBA Human Resource Management, and eight Research Programmes in Economics, Mathematics, Education, Public Policy and Public Administration, National Security Studies, Human Resource Management, English, and Tourism and Travel Management during the academic session 2013-14. Admissions were made at all-India level under the aegis of Central Universities Common Entrance Test (CUCET) 2013 formed by a collegium of 10 Central Universities viz., Central University of Bihar, Central University of Jammu, Central University of Jharkhand, Central University of Kashmir, Central University of Kerala, Central University of Rajasthan, Central University of Gujarat, Central University of Punjab, Central University of Orissa and Central University of Tamil Nadu. The Entrance Test for Under-Graduate Programmes was held on 1st and 2nd June, 2013. Although Central University of Jammu is not offering any Under-Graduate programmes yet the Test was conducted for the candidates who had applied for the Under-Graduate programmes offered by the sister Universities of the collegium and opted for the examination centre at Jammu. Subsequently, Entrance Test for Post-Graduate Programmes was held on 15th and 16th June, 2013 in offline mode in three sessions each day wherein 2725 candidates appeared. 233 candidates were admitted against the intake of 240 seats in the subjects offered by the University.

The Entrance Test for Integrated M.Phil.-Ph.D. Programmes was held on 14th July, 2013. Total number of 376 candidates appeared in the test and 41 were admitted in the Research Degree Programmes during the Academic Session 2013-14.

Further, the process for pre-conduct preparations for Entrance Test to be held during 2014 for admissions for the Academic Session 2014-15 has also been initiated. The Academic Council in its meeting held on 25th November, 2013, has approved the proposal of the University for continuing being part of CUCET-2014 for admissions during the Academic Session 2014-15. The Vice Chancellors and senior officials of the collegium partners attended a meeting on 28th December, 2013 at Association of Indian Universities House, New Delhi, where the performance of CUCET – 2013 was reviewed. Further, the Central University of Rajasthan was again approved as Nodal University for conduct of CUCET-2014, for admission of students in the participating Universities at all-India level.

Admission process for admission through CUCET-2014 has already begun with issuance of admission notice by the Nodal University on 10th March, 2014 and the last date for filling of application forms online by the candidates has been fixed as 10th April, 2014. The Central University of Jammu has advertised admission for eight Integrated M.Phil.-Ph.D. Programmes and twelve Post Graduate Programmes including four new Master's Degree Programmes, viz., Public Policy & Public Administration, National Security Studies, Mass Communication and New Media, and Social Work, as approved by the competent Authorities for the Academic Session 2014-15. Intake of 30 students for each Programme has been prescribed for

admission to all the disciplines of Master's Degree Programmes and five seats for each Integrated M.Phil.-Ph.D. Programme except Mathematics in which three seats have been prescribed as intake capacity.

Examinations and Results

The Examinations for 2nd and 4th semesters of the Academic Session 2012-13 were held in the month of June, 2013, the results of which were declared in the last week of July and first week of August, 2013 respectively. With this, first batch of Post-Graduate students in the subjects of English and Comparative Literature, Economics, Applied Mathematics and Master of Education (M.Ed.) became the first pass out alumni of the Central University of Jammu during 2013. The overall average pass percentage of the 2nd semester is 75.86 and that of 4th semester is 95.23.

Examinations for 1st and 3rd semesters students, admitted during the Academic Session 2013-14, were conducted in December, 2013 and the results were declared during the first week of February, 2014. The overall average pass percentage of 1st semester is 86.41 and that of 3rd semester is 88.72.

Recruitment of teaching faculty

During the period under report main emphasis remained on appointment of faculty on regular basis, replacing the adhoc / contract arrangement in various departments. In response to the advertisement, issued vide No.CUJ/Aptt./2011-12/Advt.(2)/3382 dated 13-02-2013, for appointment to the posts of Assistant Professors, Associate Professors and Professors in ten disciplines, namely Computer Science and Information Technology, Mathematics, Environmental Sciences, English, Educational Studies, National Security Studies, Economics, Public Policy and Public Administration, Human Resource Management and Organisational Behaviour and Tourism and Travel Management, 1461 application forms were received by the last prescribed date for receipt of applications i.e. 15th March, 2013. Meetings of the selection committees were conducted after obtaining the convenience of Visitor's nominees and Subject Experts in respective subjects/departments during May-June, 2013.

The recommendations of the selection committees in the afore-mentioned ten subjects/departments were placed before the Executive Council and having been approved in its meeting held on 29th June, 2013, letters for the appointment of 29 Assistant Professors, 01 Associate Professor and 02 Professors were issued. All of them, except 03 Assistant Professors, have joined within the stipulated time for joining.

For filling up of the remaining vacant posts, another advertisement notice was issued vide No.CUJ/Aptt./2013-14/Advt.(5)/1447-55 dated 03-08-2013. In response 569 application forms were received by the last prescribed date for receipt of application forms i.e. 6th September, 2013. Meetings of the selection committees for conduct of interviews for the advertised posts were held in October - November, 2013.

After approval of the recommendations of the selection committees, by Executive Council in its meeting held on 2nd December, 2013, 13 Assistant Professors and 01 Professor were appointed. All the appointed faculty have joined the University.

The Academic Council in its meeting held on 25th November, 2014 accorded approval for introduction of four new Master's Degree programmes in the subjects of National Security Studies, Public Policy and Public Administration, Social Work, and Mass Communication and New Media from the Academic Session 2014-15. The University has initiated the process for establishment of the departments of Social Work, and Mass Communication and New Media from Academic Session 2014-15.

14 faculty positions comprising 08 Assistant Professors, 04 Associate Professors and 02 Professors in the subjects of Social Work, and Mass Communication and New Media were advertised, vide No.CUJ/Aptt/Advt./2014-15/5756-63 dated 09-01-2014, in response to which 313 application forms were received. The meetings of the selection committees in Social Work were held on 24th and 25th Feb, 2014 and those in Mass Communication and New Media on 26th and 27th Feb, 2014. Recommendations of the selection committees were placed before the Executive Council in its meeting held on 3rd March, 2014. After approval of the Executive Council appointment orders of the 03 Assistant Professors in Social Work and 04 Assistant Professors in Mass Communication and New Media were issued.

None of the applicants was found eligible to fill up the posts of Associate Professors and Professors in both the subjects.

In view of non availability of teaching faculty at senior level walk in interviews were held in Jan, 2014 and Assistant Professors on short term contract basis for one semester were appointed to meet the academic requirement of the respective Departments.

Present faculty position in University is 10 Professors, 01 Associate Professor and 56 Assistant Professors as per details given below:-

Recruitment of Non-teaching Staff

An advertisement for filling up of 65 Non-teaching positions, which include Deputy Registrars, Assistant Registrars, System Analyst, Security Officer and other ministerial as well as technical posts has also been issued vide Advertisement No.CUJ/Aptt./2011-12/Advt(2)/1830-1835 dated 2nd September, 2013. Applications received in response to the above cited advertisement are being processed for scrutiny and short-listing of candidates will be made through written test or otherwise, depending upon the response of candidates in each category of posts, interviews for various categories of posts have been scheduled to be conducted in the month of April, 2014.

An advertisement for appointment to the posts of Finance Officer, Controller of Examinations, Librarian, Deputy Librarian and Assistant Librarian was issued vide No.CUJ/Aptt./Advt./2014/5756-63 dated 09-01-2014. Applications received have been scrutinized. Interview for the Post of Controller of Examinations has been scheduled for 2nd April, 2014. For the Post of Assistant Librarian, interviews are being fixed. None of the candidates for the posts of Librarian and Deputy Librarian has been found eligible. For the post of Finance Officer only one candidate has been found eligible even after third effort of the University to fill the post.

Appointment of Assistant Registrar

An advertisement for the posts of Deputy Registrar and that of Assistant Registrar was issued vide No. CUJ/Aptt/2011-12/Advt.(2)2142 dated 12-10-2012. The interviews for the post of Assistant Registrar and Deputy Registrar were held on 08th May, 2013. The recommendations of the selection committee were placed before the Executive Council in its meeting held on 25th May, 2013 for approval. One candidate was selected and appointed as Assistant Registrar. The position of Deputy Registrar remained unfilled for want of any suitable candidate for the post and as such the post was re-advertised. Further process for its recruitment is in progress and interview is expected to be held in April, 2014.

Appointment of Registrar

As per section 44(b) of the Central Universities Act, 2009 the first Registrar and the first Finance Officer shall be appointed by the Visitor and each of the said officers shall hold office for a period of three years.

As desired by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, the Post of Registrar was advertised vide No. CUJ/Apptt./2011-12(4)/3684 dated 20-03-2013 with last date of receipt of applications as 22nd April, 2013 which was further extended to 6th May, 2013 due to inadequate response.

Interview for the post was held on 29th May, 2013. Recommendations of the selection committee were sent to Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The Ministry, on the approval of the President of India in his capacity as the Visitor of the University, appointed Sh. Jit Singh as the first Registrar of the Central University of Jammu for the tenure of 3 years. Consequently appointment order was issued vide No.CUJ/VC/Apptt/2013/1505-1512 dated 08-08-2013. Sh. Jit Singh has since joined the Central University of Jammu on 6th September, 2013.

Appointment of Pro-Vice Chancellor

Prof. Rajive Gupta, former Dean Research Studies, University of Jammu, has been appointed as Pro-Vice-Chancellor of the University on 6th December, 2013.

Appointment of Dean Students' Welfare

Prof. N.R. Sharma, former Head of the Department of Education, University of Jammu, was appointed as Dean Students' Welfare on 6^{th} December, 2013 for a period of 3 years.

Support from UGC

The UGC has approved the tentative XII plan allocation for an amount of Rs.388.50 crore (Rupees three hundred eighty eight crore and fifty lac) vide D.O.No.F.1-1/2012(CU) dated 10th June, 2013.

Accorded approval for 75 non-teaching posts besides 100 outsourced position including 4 already sanctioned for various services of the University vide letter No.F.63-1/2010(CU) dated 10^{th} June, 2013 under XII Plan for Central University of Jammu.

The University received Rs. 80.375 crore during the 12^{th} five year plan against the approved allocation of Rs. 388.50 crore. The year wise breakup is as follows:-

Shri Ashok Thakur, IAS, Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), visited Campus site at village Bagla and Temporary Academic Block of the University, on 29th Jan, 2014. During his visit to the TAB he addressed the faculty and Heads of the Departments. He was accompanied by Sh. Mushtaq Ahmed, Secretary, Department of Higher Education, J&K Government.

Prof. R.K Kale, Vice Chancellor of Central University of Gujarat, visited the University on 12th Jan, 2014, and met the Vice Chancellor and officers of the University. During his visit to the Campus site and the Temporary Academic Block, he appreciated the University for the infrastructure development, organizing the activities and running the Research and Master Degree Programmes in a short span of two years.

Important Events

On 22nd April, 2013 Jenab Omar Abdullah, Hon'ble Chief Minister, J&K was briefed by the Vice Chancellor about various activities of the University. Main focus was laid on four points regarding handing over of land, widening of road, provision of water supply and electricity for the Campus site at Bagla. Hon'ble CM was kind enough to ensure an early action on all these issues.

A meeting with the Architect (M/S Sikka Associates) and the Project Management Consultants (Engineering Project India Ltd.) was held on 6^{th} and 7^{th} May, 2013 in which contours of Campus development were discussed and various decisions taken for early start of construction activities at the site.

A formal agreement between the Central University of Jammu and the Project Management Consultants (EPIL) was entered into on 20th May, 2013 and was signed by the Vice Chancellor and Shri S.P.S. Bakshi, Chairman-cum-Managing Director, EPIL.

A meeting of Jammu and Kashmir Advisory Council for Higher Education under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister, J&K, was attended by the Vice-Chancellor on 23rd May, 2013 at Srinagar.

Status of Land and Infrastructural Development of the University

a) Status Report regarding transfer / acquisition of land to / for the Central University of Jammu.

As reported earlier too, for establishing the Central University of Jammu, the State Government has allocated two chunks of land falling on northern and southern sides of the Raya Morh-Mandal Road. The quantum of land comes to 4880 kls 19 mls. The land is situated at village Bagla, District Samba and as per revenue records, further description of the same is as under:-

i) State land

: 4254 kls 14 mls

ii) Private land

: 584 kls 06 mls

, lii) Evacuee's land

: 41 kls 19 mls

The status of transfer /acquisition of land to/for the Central University of Jammu is as under:-

Possession of forest land measuring 3000 kanals stands handed over by the Higher Education Department and taken over by the Central University of Jammu on 6th May, 2013, while the issue concerning formalisation of MOU/Lease Agreement is in process with Higher Education Department.

Transfer of State land measuring 1254 Kanals 14 Marlas has remained a matter of dispute, for a long time, between the Higher Education Department and the Forest Department in view of existence of a number of trees/bushes over the said land. With constant follow up at all levels connected with the issue, the same is now at almost final stage. The State Cabinet, in its meeting held on 15th May, 2013, approved the proposal of Forest Department and consequently, the Forest Department has also issued formal Government Order No: 220-FST of 2013 dated 17-06-2013 allowing use of 62.70 hectare (1254 kanals) of land for establishment of Central University of Jammu. Major part of the amount of compensation claimed by the Forest Department has been arranged to be paid and now only an amount of Rs. 2463038/- has been shown as outstanding, for which the matter has been taken up with the Higher Education Department. In the meanwhile the Forest Department, vide PCCF office letter dated 20th Feb, 2014, has agreed to hand over 56 hectare (1120 kanals) of land against 62.70 hectare (1254 kanals) and the

matter is being followed with Higher Education Department. In the meantime, vide letter dated 03^{th} March, 2014, the Higher Education Department has nominated Principal, Government Degree College, Samba to liaise with concerned authorities for taking over on behalf of State Government and handing over the land to the Central University .

As regards acquisition of private and evacuee's land measuring 626 Kanals 5 Marla, the Collector Land Acquisition, Samba has since announced the final award. As per final award there was a shortfall of an amount of Rs. 67.045 lakhs on account of compensation to be paid to the ex-owners. The matter was taken up with the Higher Education Department for release of the additional funds required for the purpose. In this case too, with personal follow up, including visits to Secretariat at Srinagar/Jammu by the Consultant (LM), the requisite funds have been got transferred to the Collector. Now it is proposed to get the possession of the land transferred to the Higher Education Department on the date to be fixed by the Forest Department, in the near future.

Thus, the University is expecting the resolution of all outstanding issues and at an early date, for complete possession of the allotted land for the University Campus.

b) Infrastructure Development Initiatives at the Campus Site Village Bagla, Samba.

The University has identified and decided to take up the construction of such buildings, which can be completed up to ending June, 2014, named it as sub-phase-I of Phase-I of the campus development. The buildings identified to be taken up for construction as first priority are the Directorate of Distance Education and approximately 60 Quarters of Professors/Associate Professors/Assistant Professors along with associated services and approach roads in order to make these buildings functional and habitable. With completion of the said two types of buildings, the University intends to commence the additional academic activities of four new departments in the campus during the next Academic Session. The same would also cater to the immediate hostel needs of the students by modifying the Professors quarters and also provide residential facility to the faculty during 2014-15 session.

The Executive Council, on recommendations of the Finance Committee, approved the budget estimates of the Phase I and Sub-Phase I of the development of the University campus in its meeting held on 29th June, 2013 for an amount of Rs. 1187.91 Crores and Rs. 102.33 Crores respectively. Accordingly, EPIL (approved PMC) was conveyed the approval to initiate the tendering process. M/S EPIL floated the tender for the work of Sub-Phase I and selected the lowest bidder. M/S Nagarjun Construction Corporation Ltd (NCCL) was adjudged as the lowest bidder. The University, after seeking justification from the PMC, approved the contract. It is pertinent to mention here that the said phase has been planned to be completed on or before June, 2014, aiming at commencement of academic activity with introduction of new programmes in the main Campus for the academic session 2014-15.

The work is in progress and every effort is being made to complete the subphase I in time. The University has identified and prioritized the construction of such buildings and infrastructure out of the Phase I in order to make the Campus functional within a short span of time in commensuration with the availability of the funds. Tenders for the road network and utilities have been floated. The same will be finalized at an early date.

Apart from allotment of land for the Campus development, the State Government is to provide basic infrastructure in terms of power, water and suitable road access up to the Campus site. Though, the State Government is alive to the commitment as mentioned above, yet the proposals are still in infancy. No work has yet been started on these issues critical to the development of the Campus. The Chief Secretary, J&K Govt. convened a meeting on 16th Jan, 2014 in which Principal Secretary PDD, Commissioner Secretary R&B, Commissioner Secretary PHE and Secretary Higher Education, J&K Govt. were present. The Chief Secretary had passed instructions for tying the proposals framed by the Power Development Department, Roads and Buildings Department and getting the proposal made by the PHE Department through the Secretary Higher Education, being the Nodal authority.

It was also decided that the above mentioned Departments would initiate their respective works for the Central University of Jammu for which initial funds would be provided by the J&K Planning and Development Department. The same would further be reimbursed by the Govt. of India out of the special funds committed by the Union Cabinet Secretary during his visit to the State in April last

year, in case of Power and Water. The cost of the construction of the access road shall however be borne by the State Government. The Commissioner/Secretary, Roads and Buildings, was advised to get the land acquired without further delay to start with, for which the requisite funds would be provided by the State Government.

Item No 4: To Consider Annual Report for the year 2012-13.

Section 30(1) of the Central Universities Act, 2009 provides that the Annual Report of the University shall be prepared under the direction of the Executive Council which shall include among other matters, the steps taken by the University towards the fulfillment of its objects and shall be submitted to the Court on or before such date as may be prescribed by the Statute and the Court shall consider the report in its Annual Meeting. According to section 30(2) the Court shall submit the Annual Report to the Visitor alongwith its comments, if any.

Further, as per section 30(3) of the Act, the Annual Report shall also be submitted to the Central Government, which shall, as soon as may be, cause the same to be laid before both the Houses of Parliament. The Annual Report as prepared was placed before the Executive Council of the University in its meeting held on 2nd December, 2013. Copies of the Annual Report as approved by the Executive Council have been submitted to the Central Government, Ministry of Human Resource Development, within the prescribed time, for being laid before both Houses of Parliament.

Section 20(2)(b) of the Central Universities Act, 2009, *inter alia*, provides for the Court to consider and pass resolution on the Annual Report of the University.

The Annual Report for the period from 1st April, 2012 to 31st March, 2013 is placed before the Court for consideration as Annexure I.

Item No 5: To consider the Annual Accounts along with Audit Report for the year 2012-13.

Section 31(1) and (2) of the Central Universities Act, 2009 provides that the Annual Accounts and Balance Sheet of the University shall be prepared under the directions of the Executive Council and shall once at least every year and at intervals of not more than fifteen months, be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India or by such persons as he may authorize in this behalf. A copy of the Annual Accounts together with the Audit Report thereon shall be submitted to the Court and the Visitor alongwith the observations of the Executive Council.

Accordingly, the Annual Accounts of the University for the period 1st April, 2012 to 31st March, 2013 were compiled in accordance with principles and procedures laid down by Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, and as per the guidelines of the UGC. The Accounts were prepared on accrued basis. The compiled Annual Accounts were considered and approved by the Finance Committee and the Executive Council in their meetings held on 22nd June, 2013 and 29th June, 2013 respectively before submission to CAG for auditing.

The CAG Audit party completed the auditing of the Accounts and the Director General (Audit) Chandigarh on behalf of CAG issued the Separate Audit Report (SAR) for the year 2012-13 vide letter No.DGA/CE/SAR/CUT/13-14/201-202 dated 31st October, 2013.

The Annual Accounts along with SAR for the year 2012-13 as recommended by the Finance Committee in its meeting held on 18th November, 2013 was approved by the Executive Council in its meeting held on 2nd December, 2013.

Copies of the Annual Accounts along with SAR, as approved by the Executive Council, has been submitted to the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Central Government, for laying before both Houses of Parliament in terms of section 31(4) of the Act.

Section 20(2)(b) of the Act, *inter-alia*, provides for the Court to consider and pass resolution on the Annual Accounts of the University and the Audit Report on such accounts.

The Annual Accounts along with Separate Audit Report for the year 2012-13 is placed before the Court for consideration as Annexure-II.

Item No 6: To consider the Revised Estimates for the year 2013-14 and the Budget Estimates for the year 2014-15.

The Central Universities Act, 2009, Statute 10(2) provides that at an annual meeting of the Court, a report of the working of the University during the previous year, together with a statement of receipt and expenditure, the balance sheet as audited, and the financial estimates for the next year shall be presented.

The estimates were based on actual flow of funds for expenditure under revenue and capital items. During the year 2012-13, the University had eight P.G. programmes and four integrated M.Phil-Ph.D. programmes. During the Financial Year 2013-14, the University started four more integrated M.Phil-Ph.D programmes. The increase in capital and revenue expenditure is attributed to academic and construction activities at the Campus site.

The University had unspent balance of Rs 2925.08 lakh as on Ist April, 2013 which was taken as the opening balance for the financial year 2013-14. An amount of Rs 134.00 lakh is anticipated as income during the year 2013-14. The demand projected for the year 2013-14 was estimated to be Rs 21927.66 lakh against which the Revised Estimates for the year 2013-14 are Rs. 24476.95 lakh. Out of this, Rs. 22000.00 Lakh are expected from UGC as Grant-in-Aid under General Development Scheme. The Budget Estimates for the financial year 2014-15 are Rs. 27644.30 lakh. The funds amounting to Rs. 27000.00 lakh are required as G.I.A. from UGC after taking into account an estimated income of Rs. 107.50 lakh and Rs. 582.13 lakh as opening Balance for the year 2014-15. Thus, leaving a closing balance of Rs.45.33 lakh to meet out the requirements of the first quarter of the next financial year. The budget estimates have been prepared keeping in view the construction activities already initiated and scheduled to be started in upcoming financial year at Campus site and other recurring expenses including salaries.

The Revised Estimates for the year 2013-14 and the Budget Estimates for the year 2014-15 were discussed in the meeting of the Finance Committee held on 18th November, 2013. The Finance Committee resolved to approve the item and recommended the same for consideration of the Executive Council.

The Executive Council in its meeting held on 2nd December, 2013 approved the recommendations of the Finance Committee.

The Revised Estimates for the year 2013-14 and the Budget Estimates for the year 2014-15 are placed before the Court for consideration as Annexure-III.

Item No 7: To consider fixation of date for the next meeting of the Court.

The Central Universities Act, 2009, Statute 10 (1) provides that an Annual meeting of the Court shall be held on a date to be fixed by the Executive Council unless some other date has been fixed by the Court in respect of any year.

The matter is submitted for consideration of the Court.
