# 15<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Executive Council to be held on 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 at 11:30 AM

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To peruse report of the Vice Chancellor about the developmental activities in the University since the last meeting of the Executive Council held on 31st August, 2018.

1. During the period under report, emphasis has been on strengthening the existing academic programmes and infusing a strong rigour into the ongoing research initiatives. During the current academic year, the University has offered **48 programmes** (10 UG, 17 PG & 21 Ph.D) across different disciplines: Social Sciences, Humanities, Sciences, Management, Vocation, etc. In addition, UGC in March, 2019, has sanctioned 03 new Departments viz. Department of Law, Department of Visual and Performing Arts and Department of Tourism Management. Case has been taken up to sanction Department of Earth Sciences instead of already functional Department of Tourism and Travel Management which stand approved.

- c) He/ she must have joined CU Jammu after tendering technical resignation and exercised his options of lien in writing (with or without lien).
- d) He / she must have been a regular confirmed employee in his / her previous organization
- e) Unclaimed previous service benefits, if due to employee, should be deposited by the employee through his / her previous employer
- f) Retirement benefits, pension etc paid earlier or hereafter by the previous employer will be adjusted / deducted from the date such benefits have become operative / applicable

The HEFA has been governed by a Board of Directors (BoD) chaired by the Secretary (Higher Education) Government of India and 6 other Directors. There is an Apex Advisory Committee (AAC) chaired by the Hon'ble Minister of Human Resource Development.

The MHRD vide letter F.No.61-1/2018-desk(U) dated 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2019 has intimated that the Cabinet has approved **Rs.123.00 Crore** Non-Recurring (capital) expenditure for Central University of Jammu to be funded by HEFA as loan for the construction of following projects:

(i) One Hostel each for Boys and Girls (500 students each)
 (ii) One Academic Block with Lab
 (iii) Library
 15,000 Sqm
 7,500 Sqm
 4,000 Sqm

In view of the above, the Central University of Jammu has applied for HEFA loan amounting to **Rs. 123.00 Crore** for construction of above projects in addition to the grant to be released by MHRD through UGC.

Further, HEFA has sanctioned term loan of **Rs. 123** Crores to the University vide sanction letter no. SAN/CUJM/312/2019-20 dated 24.10.2019 at the interest rate of **8.5%** per annum (subject to revision / reset from time to time), to be repaid in 20 half yearly installments of Rs. 6.15 Crores each installments plus interest. 90% loan amount shall be paid by MHRD (Rs. 5.535 Crores per half yearly installment) and 10% to be paid by the University from internal resources (Rs. 0.615 crores per half yearly installment). The entire interest component shall be repaid out of the MHRD grants. Registrar of the University may be authorized to sign the MoU / other documents prepared by HEFA on behalf of the University and Finance Officer may be authorized to operate the account and to release the loan amount to the HEFA on half yearly basis. **Annexure - IV** 

The matter is placed before Executive Council for approval.



To present Annual Accounts for the Financial year 2018-2019 of the University before the Executive Council duly recommended by Finance Committee

The Central Universities Act, 2009 under sub-section 1 of section 31 provides that "the Annual Accounts and Balance Sheet of the University shall be prepared under the directions of Executive Council and shall, once at least every year and at intervals of not more than fifteen months, be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India or by such persons as he may authorize in this behalf."

Accordingly, the Annual Accounts for the University for the periods 01-04-2018 to 31-03-2019 were compiled in accordance with principles and procedures laid down by Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education and as per the guidelines of the UGC. The Accounts have been prepared on accrual basis. The compiled accounts were placed before and considered by the Finance Committee in its 17<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2019 before submission to CAG for auditing.

The auditing of the Annual Accounts is a time bound process and in view of the urgency immediate action was required to approve the Annual Accounts before submission to the CAG office for auditing. The Vice Chancellor has approved the Annual Accounts in pursuance of the powers vested in him as per provisions laid down in the central Universities Act, 2009, Clause 11 Sub-Clause (3).

The CAG team audited the accounts and completed the job on 27.06.2019. The draft SAR was received on 22.07.2019 and the reply of the same has been furnished on 31.07.2019.

In view of the above, the action taken by the Vice Chancellor in approving the Annual Accounts duly recommended by the Finance Committee in its 17<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2019 may be confirmed. Detailed Annual Accounts 2018-19 are placed at **Annexure** – **V** for approval.

The MHRD vide their letter No. 19-15/2004-IFD (VOL. 5) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2019 has approved the enhancement of mandatory contribution by the Central Government for its employees covered under NPS Tier 1 from the existing 10 % to 14%.

The University has implemented the enhancement in NPS contribution as per the instructions of the MHRD intimated through email dated 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2019. **Annexure - VIII**

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Dr. Parmod Kumar was appointed as Assistant Professor in the Department of Educational Studies on 05.07.2013 in Pay Band -3 (Rs. 15,600-39,100/- with AGP 6,000).

To ensure smooth functioning of the following offices, the Vice Chancellor in exercise of power vested by Clause 11(3), Central Universities Act, 2019, has assigned the additional responsibility to the employees of the University in addition to their existing duties and fixed monthly honorarium as given below.

All these posts and duties shall be tenable for a maximum period of 2 years at a time or until Competent Authority decides to effect changes in the interest of the administration or whichever is earlier.

The matter is placed before Executive Council for ratification.



# To consider confirmation of faculty on completion of probation period

Ordinance No. 11 governing condition of service of teachers appointed in the University provides that:

## "Period of Probation and Confirmation

- 4. Every teacher shall be appointed on probation for a period of 12 months which may be extended by the Executive Council, by a further period of up to 12 months, subject to the condition that the total period of probation shall in no case exceed twenty four months.
- 5. The case of a teacher on probation shall be placed before the Executive Council by the Registrar. In case the Executive Council decides not to confirm a teacher, whether before the end of twelve months' period of his/her probation, or before the end of the extended period of probation, as the case may be, he/she shall be informed in writing to that effect not later than thirty days from the date of notification of minutes of Executive Council. In that case, his/her services under the University shall be terminated without notice."

The following faculty members were appointed by the University during the year 2017-2018 as per dates mentioned against their names. The date of completion of their probation period of one year is as follows:

# To consider total past service instead of stage wise service for promotion of teachers under CAS

Central University of Jammu has appointed faculty at entry level i.e. Assistant Professor (Stage-I) under direct recruitment who have already have served in the equivalent UGC pay scale and at same level in other Universities / Colleges.

In order to attract experienced faculty in the University and to safeguard their promotional avenues it is proposed that, "an Assistant Professor joining the University with a minimum of 12 years of past service shall be eligible for promotion to the post of Associate Professor (stage-4) irrespective of length of service in any stage for counting the past service rendered by faculty member for purpose of CAS. In all such cases the candidates shall be assessed on the basis of API score in category III alone, provided the concerned faculty member had applied through proper channel to Central University of Jammu at the time of their appointment in this University In such cases the seniority of already CAS promoted shall not be affected in the present or future considerations."

Pertinent to mention that such a provision is already in force in Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi

The matter is placed before the Executive Council for consideration and for forwarding to the UGC.



To consider the recommendation of Selection Committees for promotion under Career Advancement Scheme at the level of Professor and Associate Professor

Pursuant to clause 5 of UGC Regulations, 2018, the Competent Authority has constituted various Selection Committees to conduct interview of eligible faculty for promotion under Career Advancement Scheme. Accordingly, the University conducted interviews on 11.09.2019 as detailed below:

The Central University of Jammu invited applications for the post of Professors / Associate Professors / Assistant Professors under rolling advertisement (Online Mode - 1<sup>st</sup> Phase) dated 20.05.2019 placed at **Annexure - XI**.

Applications were scrutinized by the committees comprising external experts. Interviews for the post of Professors / Associate Professors / Assistant Professors were conducted during 10-12 October, 2019.

As per Honourable High Court of Jammu & Kashmir the result of Dr Vipin..... (the petitioner – PDF Kothari Fellowship, Deptt of Zoology) shall not be declared. The CUJ is approaching the Honourable High Court of Jammu & Kashmir to allow open the sealed envelope in respect of Deptt of Zoology as the petitioner has been allowed to appear in the interview of the said Selection Committee. The recommendations of the Selection Committees in sealed envelopes are placed before the Executive Council for approval.

The matter is placed before the Executive Council for consideration and approval.



To consider the draft Guidelines for inter-se-seniority of faculty in the University appointed under Direct Recruitment / Promotion under CAS.

The Vice Chancellor constituted a committee to draft guidelines for fixation of inter-se seniority amongst faculty in the University. Further a sub-committee of Executive Council consisting of Prof. M.I. Haque and Prof. Ashok Ogra (former members of the Executive Council) has also been consulted for drafting Guidelines to determine inter-se seniority.

The Committee has submitted draft guidelines which are placed at Annexure - XII

The matter is placed before the Executive Council for approval.



To confirm the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in abolishing Ordinance No. 35 governing appointment of faculty against sanctioned posts under exigent situations

Clause 37 (1) of Central Universities Act, 2009 provides that the first Ordinances made under subsection (2) of section 28 may be amended, repealed or added to any time by the Executive Council. Accordingly, the University framed Ordinance no 35 along with other 54 Ordinances to meet scarcity of experienced faculty and the same were submitted to MHRD vide letter no. F.52-8/2016-CU.III dated 15.06.2017 for approval. However, the MHRD has forwarded the UGC letter no F.72-4/2013(CU) dated 10.10.2017 to the University containing various observations. With regard to Ordinance no 35, the UGC has observed that:

"As now, the existence of the University is about 7 years old, there is no need to frame this ordinance and University may be asked to fill up the regular teaching positions at the earliest as requested by MHRD / UGC repeatedly from time to time as suggested earlier"

The Vice Chancellor in exercise of powers vested by Clause 11(3), Central Universities Act, 2009 has approved the abolition of Ordinance no 35.

The matter is placed before the Executive Council for ratification.



# Adoption of UGC Guidelines issued since inception of the university and not adopted till date

The Cuj became functional in August 2011 and since then the university has been adopting the UGC Guidelines in piecemeal/on need or demand basis. In the process some UGC Guidelines have not been adopted inadvertently.

It is proposed to adopt all the UGC Guidelines that are applicable to newly established central university from Aug 2009 till date so that in future such UGC Guidelines are adopted received since last EC meeting.

The matter is placed before the Executive Council for Approval.



# To conduct of 2<sup>nd</sup> Convocation of the University in First Quarter of the year 2020

On 18th March, 2018, Central University of Jammu conducted its 1st Convocation in the General Zorawar Singh, Auditorium, University of Jammu. His Holiness the 14th Central University of Jammu Agenda: 14 th Meeting of the Executive Council dated 31st August, 2018 [2] Lama was the Chief Guest. Besides, Prof. Amitabh Mattoo as Guest of Honour and a galaxy of political leaders, academicians, bureaucrats, senior members of security forces, prominent members of civil society and school children attended the maiden convocation of the university. Degrees of Honorus Causa were conferred upon Dr. Jitender Singh, MoS, GoI and General N.C. Vij, former Chief of the Army Staff, in recognition of their outstanding contribution to the public life. The University students from 2011 to 2017 batches were awarded 14 Ph.D., 20 M.Phil and 885 Post Graduate degrees. Since then 03 Ph.D degrees have been awarded.

The university proposes to conduct of 2<sup>nd</sup> Convocation of the University in First Quarter of the year 2020. Accordingly the following may be considered:

- a) Award of degrees, merit certificate and medals to qualified students/scholars
- b) Nominees for award of **Honoris Causa** (Ph.D.) degree/s if any
- c) Expenditure as per actual
- d) Empower Vice Chancellor to decide on all issues related to 2<sup>nd</sup> Convocation of the University.

The matter is placed before the Executive Council for Approval.



To consider the report on Deans Committee on Guidelines for enhancement of financial assistance to the university teachers for attending national / international conference / seminar / symposia/ congress/ workshops /short duration training programme within India and abroad.

1. Only duty leave, not more than 30 days may be granted without financial assistance on the part of the University, if the teacher is not presenting any paper in the Workshop/Training Programme within India and Abroad.

#### 2. CRITERIA FOR SELECTION WITH FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- a) TRAVEL GRANT TO TEACHERS TO ATTEND THE CONFERENCE/ SEMINAR/ SYMPOSIA/ CONGRESS ABROAD
  - i. Granting of financial assistance will depend on the grant received from UGC for the purpose and availability of funds in the University
  - ii. This condition can only be relaxed by Vice Chancellor in very special cases as an exception subject to availability of funds.
  - iii. Not more than one person per department will be allowed to attend the same conference abroad. In case of two and more applications youngest teacher may be preferred over the Senior teacher, to promote & update his/her knowledge and provide the younger teacher better opportunities which will enable him/her to perform better.
  - iv. In case of more than one faculty member /a group from the same Department, deputation should be considered based on the specific recommendations with reasons of the concerned Head/Dean of the Department/School specifically mentioning that the work of Department will not suffer. In these cases preference will be given to those applicants who have secured partial assistance from external sponsors/source.
  - v. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final.
- b) AVAILABLE ONLY TO THE CONFIRMED PERMANENT UNIVERSITY FACULTY.

The faculty who are on Probation against regular post will also be considered for financial support by the university.

#### c) ELIGIBILITY FOR TRAVEL GRANT:

i. Those invited to attend international academic conferences/ seminars/ symposia/Congress. The level of the program and the reputation of the institution organizing (Recognized universities of National/International repute) the event should also be truly international, professional and capable of enhancing the skills or adding to the professional accomplishment of the beneficiary.



- ii. Poster presentation and mere participations will not be considered for any financial assistance
- iii. Applicants proven record of research output and publication related to the previously attended conference/presentation for which financial assistance was taken, if any, will be important criteria for getting financial support from the university.
- (iv) Financial assistance may be provided in the following order of preference:
  - i. Those invited to Chair a session.
  - ii. Teachers delivering key-note addresses/plenary lectures.
  - iii. Those contributing a paper/paper presentation.
  - iv. Those invited under International Collaboration Exchange programmes.
  - v. Those invited to give symposia talks/invited lectures.
- (v) Acceptance of paper from organizers should have been received

#### 4. AMOUNT OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR CONFERENCES ETC. AT ABROAD

Actual amount (inclusive of TA/DA and Registration fee) will be decided case by case subject to the maximum amounts as given below:

Maximum financial support of ₹ 100000 (One Lakh) will be awarded to the faculty per year irrespective of the conference numbers provided duty leaves are available. Teachers may also be allowed to bear the balance of expenses from their own resources.

#### 5. AMOUNT OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR CONFERENCES Etc. WITHIN INDIA

TRAVEL GRANT TO TEACHERS TO ATTEND THE CONFERENCE/ SEMINAR/ SYMPOSIA/ CONGRESS/ WORKSHOPS/ SHORT DURATION TRAINING PROGRAMME WITHIN INDIA

- a) Actual T.A. expenditure (inclusive of Actual Train Fare AC II tier) and Registration Fee to a maximum of ₹ 30,000/-.
- b) Available to teachers not more than once in a financial year.
- c) No more than 20% of the existing number of teachers of one Department shall be deputed to Conferences in India at any given time. This number shall not exceed 5 in any case. he department wise maximum numbers of the teachers to be deputed will be admissible as per the following table:

# **Enactment of Special mode of appointment**

Clause 19 (1) of Statues of the University, Central Universities Act, 2009 provides that:

"19 (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in Statues 18, the Executive Council may invite a person of high academic distinction and professional attainments to accept a post of Professor or Associate Professor or any other equivalent post in academic in the University on such terms and conditions as it deems fit and on the person agreeing to do so appoint him to the post.

Provided that the Executive Council may also create supernumerary posts for a specified period for appointment of such persons.

Provided further that the number supernumerary posts so created should not exceed five percent of the total posts in the University"

The matter is placed before the Executive Council for Approval and for onward submission to the UGC as per Tri partite Agreement (CUJ, UGC & MHRD)



To consider mandatory Affidavit with any complaints against university statutory officers to ensure genuineness of complaint and speedy redress/action.

In the last eight years of existence of the university it has been documented that innumerable anonymous/pseudo frivolous/baseless/malafide allegations/complaints are leveled against university officers, Immense avoidable resources of the university are wsted in investigation and responding to such allegations/complaints,

The university is committed to fair, transparent and justified functioning of all its public offices/officers. But motivated complaints/allegations are leveled and circulated to tarnish/jeopardize the image and growth trajectory of the university for ulterior aims of such anonymous/pseudo named allegations/complaints.

To arrest this trend, deter motivated adverse propaganda and to ensure speedy and fair justice/redress/action on complaints/allegations leveled by genuine citizens, it is proposed to make a mandatory requirement of Affidavit with any complaints/allegation against university statutory officers.

  Provided that if the Visitor does not approve any of the persons included in the panel, he may call for an extended fresh panel.
- 2 (II) The Committee referred to in clause (I) shall consist of Five persons, out of whom three shall be nominated by the Executive Council and two by the Visitor, and one of the nominees of the Visitor shall be convener of the Committee.

  Provided that none of the members of the Committee shall be an employee of the University or a College or an Institution maintained by the University or a member of any authority of the University".

No 52-4/2019-CU.III dated 5<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 has requested Central University of Jammu to convene the meeting of the Executive Council of the University and provide three nominees of the Executive Council to be the members of the Committee for making selection to the post of Vice-Chancellor, CUJ.
