PROFESSOR (All subjects except Management)

A. (i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.

(ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college, and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions/industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level. (Must have been

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awarded at least one Ph.D. Degree under the supervision of the applicant for which, evidence is to be verified).

(iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process. (In case there is no evidence available to verify the involvement of the candidates in this clause, the candidates be informed to bring their record at the time of interview under prior intimation to the concerned office).

(iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in UGC Regulation on minimum Qualifications for appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities & Colleges and Measures of Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2010 along with its amendment from time to time.

B. An outstanding professional, with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR (All subjects except Management)

i. Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.

ii. A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).

iii. A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.

iv. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students. (Must have submitted atleast one Ph.D. thesis under supervision of the candidate).

v. A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in UGC Regulation on minimum Qualifications for appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities & Colleges and Measures of Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2010 along with its amendment from time to time.

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (All subjects except Management)

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT OF TEACHING FACULTY IN UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES - MANAGEMENT/ BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION:

PROFESSOR:

- i. Consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in Master's Degree in Business Management / Administration / in a relevant discipline or consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in two year full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / recognized by the AICTE / UGC;

OR

First Class graduate and professionally qualified Chartered Accountant / Cost and works Accountant / Company Secretary of the concerned statutory body.

- ii. Ph. D. or Fellow of Indian Institute of Management or of an Institute recognized by AICTE and declared equivalent by the AIU.
- iii. A minimum of ten years' experience of teaching / industry / research / professional out of which five years must be at the level of Reader or equivalent excluding the period spent for obtaining the research degree.

OR

- iv. In the event the candidate is from industry and the profession, the following shall constitute as essential:

1. Consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in Master's Degree in Business Management / Administration / in a relevant management related discipline or consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in two years full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / recognized by the AICTE / UGC.

2. The candidate should have professional work experience which is significant and can be recognized at national / International level as equivalent to Ph. D. and twelve years' managerial experience in industry / profession of which at least eight years should be at least at a level comparable to that of Reader/Assistant Professor.

i. Consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in Master's Degree in Business Management / Administration / in a relevant management related discipline or first class in two years full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / recognized by the AICTE / UGC;

OR

First Class graduate and professionally qualified Chartered Accountant / Cost and works Accountant / Company Secretary of the concerned statutory body.

ii. Ph.D. or Fellow of Indian Institute of Management or of an Institute recognized by AICTE and declared equivalent by the AIU.

iii. A minimum of eight years' experience of teaching / industry / research / professional at managerial level excluding the period spent for obtaining the research degree.

OR

iv. In the event the candidate is from industry and the profession, the following requirements shall constitute as essential requirements:

1. Consistently good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in Master's Degree in Business Management / Administration / in a relevant management related discipline or first class in two years full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / recognized by AICTE / UGC,

OR

First Class graduate and professionally qualified Chartered Accountant / Cost and Works Accountant / Company Secretary of the concerned statutory body.

2. A minimum of ten years experience of teaching industry / research / profession, out of which five years must be at the level of Assistant Professor or equivalent excluding the period spent for obtaining research degree. The candidate should have Professional work experience, which is significant and can be recognized at national / international level as equivalent to Ph.D. and ten years managerial experience in industry / profession of which at least five years should be at the level comparable to that of lecturer / assistant professor.
- v. Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:
- a) Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
 - b) Published work, such as research papers, patents filed / obtained, books and / or technical reports; and
 - c) Experience of guiding the project work /dissertation of PG / Research Students or supervising R&D projects in industry.

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR

i. Essential:

1. First Class Masters Degree in Business Management / Administration / in a relevant management related discipline or first class in two year full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / accredited by the AICTE / UGC;
OR
2. First Class graduate and professionally qualified Chartered Accountant / Cost and Works Accountant / Company Secretary of the concerned statutory bodies.

ii. Desirable:

1. Teaching, research, industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;

2. Papers presented at Conferences and / or published in refereed journals.

OTHER CONDITIONS:

1. The candidates must enter the relevant score in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based on Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) as given in API Score Sheet in the application form for the post of Professor/ Associate Professor as per revised regulations of UGC (4th Amendment, 2016). Each API score must be supported by the documentary evidence which should be objectively verifiable, without which no claim on account of API score would be entertained. The API score shall be calculated as per revised regulations of UGC 2016 (4th Amendment).
2. In case of all teaching positions, the application form must be accompanied by detailed curriculum vitae giving details of academic qualifications, experience, published work etc. the publication part in the CV should invariably contain details with regard to the title of the journal/book, title of the Research Paper, Vol. No., Page Nos. year of publication, ISSN/ISBN, sole-author/co-authors/joint publication, refereed/non-refereed, indexed/non-indexed and local/National/International status etc. These details shall be enclosed with documentary evidence to be used to verify the API claim. Physical copy of the publications shall only be accepted for giving weightages for API Score. Any reference for online verification of publications shall not be accepted. Such original documents shall be required to be produced at the time of interview.
3. As per 4th amendment of UGC regulations (2010), relaxation of 5% marks (from 55% to 50%) shall also be provided at the Master's level to those Ph.D. Degree holders, who have passed their Master's Degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in the point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories (SC/ST/OBC/PwD) are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
4. The period put in by the candidates to acquire M.Phil. and / or the residency period prescribed for pursuing Ph.D. shall not be counted towards teaching/research experience. Candidates must provide the details with regard to said period in the application forms.
5. The experience of the candidates working in any accredited research organization/academic institution be counted provided the candidates working in such organization have drawn gross emoluments equivalent to or more than the gross salary of the Assistant Professors.
6.
 - i. The reservation for the SC/ST/OBC/Persons with Disabilities is as per the Govt. of India rules.
 - ii. Candidate applying under quota reserved for Person with Disabilities should indicate whether he/she belongs to SC/ST/OBC or General Category.
 - iii. Person suffering from not less than 40% of the relevant disability shall alone be eligible for the benefit of reservation for Person with Disabilities.

7. Candidates seeking reservation under OBC category are required to submit certificates on the format prescribed by the Government of India, Department of Personnel & Training, Socially & Educationally Backward Class (SEBC) vide OM No. 36036/2/2013-Estt.(Res.) dated 30.05.2014. Candidates will be considered as OBC only if they submit the required valid caste certificates in the prescribed format mentioning creamy layer exclusion. Further, they shall submit the declaration given in the application form.
8. The appointment under reserved category shall be provisional and subject to certificate being verified through the proper channels. If the verification reveals that the claim of the candidate to a particular category is false, his/her services will be terminated forthwith without assigning any further reasons and without prejudice to such further action as may be taken under the provisions of the Indian Panel Code/ Ranbir Panel Code for production of false certificates.
9. Candidates who have been awarded Ph.D. from foreign Universities should enclose "Equivalence Certificates", issued by the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi, without which their candidature will not be considered and application will be rejected.
10. NET/SLET/SET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.
11. The candidates registered for the M.Phil./Ph.D. programme prior to 11 July, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bylaws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-
 - a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
 - b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
 - c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
 - d) Candidate has published two research papers from /based on his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
 - e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.

(a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice-Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs)/Dean (University Instructions) or any other equivalent position authorised by the concerned University. In the absence of a certificate from the specified dignitary, mere possession of Ph.D. degree will not be sufficient to be eligible.
12. The eligibility of candidates will be determined on the last date fixed for submission of application form.


13. The selected candidates shall be appointed under a written contract.
14. The medium of instruction in the University is English except for the Languages.
15. The recruitment to the advertised posts shall be carried out in accordance with the revised UGC Regulations, 2016.
16. Age of superannuation for all teaching positions shall be as per UGC norms.
17. All the appointees including the in-service candidates shall be governed by the New Pension Scheme (NPS) introduced by the Govt. of India.
18. Applicants not found suitable for higher positions may be considered for lower positions in the same area of specialization. The short listing of candidates by the screening committee for the post of Assistant Professors shall be done as per approved criteria available along with the application form.
19. The prescribed qualifications and experience will be minimum and the mere fact of possessing the same will not entitle a candidate to be called for interview. The number of candidates to be called for interview shall be based on the recommendations of a Screening Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor for the purpose. The Screening Committee shall make recommendations to restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview on the basis of an approved criteria i.e. twenty (20) candidates for first vacancy and ten (10) candidates for every additional vacancy in order of their rank in the list prepared by screening committee on the basis of points secured by the candidates.
20. Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent to 55% wherever the grading system is followed by the recognized University shall also be considered eligible. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to provide equivalence certificate for grade earned.
21. The NCTE Act 1993 extends to whole of India except the state of J&K for considering qualifications for the appointment of teachers in the discipline of education.
22. No TA/DA shall be paid to the candidates for attending the interview. However, the SC/ST candidates will be paid second-class railway/bus fare by shortest route on production of tickets.
23. Applicant already in the employment shall be required to route his/her application through proper channel. He/she shall, however, submit an advance copy of his/her application to the University. The application form duly forwarded by his/her employer must reach the University at least ten days prior to the date of interview, failing which he/she shall not be called for the interview.
24. Application not accompanied by necessary supporting verifiable documents, attested copies of degree certificates/marksheet/experience certificates/category certificate (if applicable), publications, teaching/research experience issued by the competent authority and the incomplete applications shall be rejected summarily.
25. The University shall verify the antecedents/documents submitted by the candidates at the time of appointment and or any time during the tenure of the service. In case, it is detected that the documents submitted are fake or the

- candidate has a clandestine antecedents/background and has suppressed the said information, his/her services shall be terminated forthwith.
26. Candidates who desire to apply for more than one post will be required to submit separate application on the prescribed format along with the specified supporting documents and application fee.
 27. Before applying for a post, candidates are advised to satisfy themselves about their eligibility.
 28. In case the last date fixed for receipt of applications is declared a holiday, next working day shall be deemed to be the last date for receiving the forms.
 29. Candidates are advised to attach a duly signed list of enclosures with the application form.
 30. Any change of address given in the application form should at once be communicated to the University.
 31. If the space provided in the application form is insufficient, information may be given on a separate sheet duly signed by the candidate and the same may be attached with the application form.
 32. In case of any dispute, any suit or legal proceedings by or against the University, Courts within whose local Jurisdiction, Headquarter of the University is situated shall have the Jurisdiction.

The detailed eligibility conditions and prescribed application form is available only on the University website (www.cujammu.ac.in). The downloaded application form, complete in all respects must be sent to the **Deputy Registrar (Admin-HRW), Central University of Jammu, Rahya-Suchani (Bagla), District Samba, Pin-181143, Jammu, J&K along with a Demand Draft of Rs 500/-** (fee exempted for candidates belonging to SC, ST and Persons with Disabilities) from any National/Scheduled Bank drawn in favour of Finance Officer, Central University of Jammu payable at Jammu, through Registered/Speed Post only, so as to reach on or before **07th December, 2017 up to 5:00 PM**. The **post applied for, "Advertisement number and Date"** shall be superscribed on the left top side of the cover. The University shall not be responsible for postal delay. Applications received after the last date will be summarily rejected and no further correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.

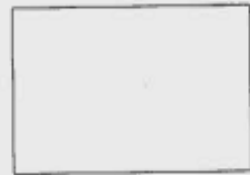
