The other decisions taken by the Vice Chancellor pertaining to B.Tech. programmes for Study in the University, is hereby approved. The examination and the evaluation pattern will be decided by the committee formed by the Vice Chancellor and the same to be implemented from the session 2022-2023. However, the committee should examine the different patterns adopted by the various institute of national importance.

It is also approved that the decision of the meeting held with Dean IIST and other faculty members that :

- 1. Indian Institute of Space Science and Technology (IIST), Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala will act as a mentor for these Engineering Courses
- 2. These B.Tech Courses will be Dual-Degree (B.Tech M.Tech) Programmes in respective areas and admissions to these Programmes will be through JEE (Mains/Advanced)





- 3. Syllabus of B.Tech. in Electronics & Communication Engineering (Avionics) will be at par with IIST as far as possible.
- 4. Faculty / Student Exchange program with IIST and the University and use of Lab facilities between IIST & the University
- 5. Involvement of faculty and students of the University for Nano Satellite Launch

It has been observed that the student used to submit hard bound copies of the thesis for the evaluation purpose to the examination section. The thesis is sent to the examiner and they are returned back to the examination section with the remark for some corrections as suggested. The candidate has to rebound the copies and resubmit the corrected copy to the examination section. This process requires lot of expenditure to be done by the student. In order to avoid this wastage of the money, it has been decided that the student can submit spiral bind copy to the examination section for evaluation purpose. After the evaluation is over and the corrections are incorporated the student has to submit the hard bound copies to the examination section. The viva-voce examination of the candidate will only be conducted after the submission of the hard bound copy to the examination section duly verified by them. This has been approved by the council to be implemented from the date of conduction of academic council meeting.

In order to promote the research environment in the University and to improve the quality of the research, it has been decided to publish the paper or to file the patent by the student before the submission of the Master dissertation for the various programmes. However, the student should be encouraged to publish the paper in the SCI/SSCI/SCI(Expanded)/Scopus Indexed Journal, Conference Proceedings and book chapters. However, from the academic session 2023-2024, it will be the compulsory part of the curriculum. Hence, this should be given vide publicity among the students and Dean Research should conduct a meeting (department wise) with the students to promote the research environment.
