 - ii. Financial bid will be downloaded and opened only after technical evaluation is complete and financial bids of only those bidders will be opened who are technically substantially responsive.
- 7. The bid for the consultancy services shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **120 days** from the date of opening of bids. If any bidder/tender withdraws his bid/tender before the said period or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the bid, his Bid security declaration would be invoked.
- 8. No Engineer of Gazetted rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the State Government/University is allowed to work as a Consultant for a period of two years after his retirement from Government service, without permission of the Government. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the Consultant or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the Consultancy Service.

Digital Certificate:

1) Introduction:

The CUJ intends to engage an Architect consultant for the construction of new project and thus invites offers from established Architects/Architect Firms for "Providing Architectural Consultancy including Planning, Designing, Architectural, Structural and Engineering Services for the construction of KALAM CENTER FOR SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY funded by DRDO in the university campus at Rahya-Suchani, Distt.- Samba - 181143".

2) Scope of work:

- A. Construction of "KALAM CENTER FOR SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY" in University Campus at Bagla, Distt. Samba (J&K). Approx. cost = Rs. 6.83 Cr.
- B. The Consultant shall provide the services in respect of the following works for the proposed building(s):
 - i. Site evaluation and analysis in the context of local terrain, soil, slope and topographical condition.
 - ii. Provide Conceptual Design/drawings.
 - iii. Providing Architectural drawings including plans, elevations, sections, working/good for construction drawings.
 - iv. Schematic layout of Exterior & Interior of the building.
 - v. Structural design.
 - vi. Preparation of detailed estimate and Bill of Quantities (BOQ).
 - vii. Assisting CUJ in the preparation of complete tender document along with details of specifications for the purpose of inviting tenders and in the evaluation of the bids received.
 - viii. Provide detailed drawings for Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing, Sanitation, Sewerage, Heating, Ventilation and Air-Conditioning (HVAC), Communication, Fire fighting & safety, Security Systems, Lifts, Waste Management system, Building Management System and other details as required.

- xii. Paying periodic site visits during execution of work as per the requirement and /or demand of CUJ.

3) Bid Offer:

The Bids will be uploaded along with all signed and scanned documents those are required for the tender. The Technical Bid shall consist of compliance to eligibility requirements and compliance to all terms and conditions as mentioned at Clause 3.1 & 3.2 below. The Financial Bid shall contain the financial quote in the prescribed format (Annexure V).

3.1 Pre-qualification Criteria for opening of Technical Bid:

- **A.** To qualify for award of the contract, each bidder should have completed during last five years FY: 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21 upto 31/03/2021:
- a) One assignment of similar nature of work costing more than or equal to 5.47 Cr. or
- b) Two assignments of similar nature of work each costing more than or equal to 3.42 Cr. or
- c) Three assignments of similar nature of work each costing more than or equal to 2.74 Cr.

Similar nature of Work is the work as defined in the Clause 2 (B) above.

3.2 Documents (self attested) to be enclosed with technical Bid:

- a) Certificate of Registration of the Consultant/ Consultancy firm with the Council of Architecture (COA)
- b) PAN Card/TAN/GOODS AND SERVICE TAXIN.
- c) EMD of Rs. 28,000/- (Rs. Twenty Eight Thousand Only) in shape of FDR/DD/TDR /online payment in favour of I/C Finance officer, Central University of Jammu. The copy of FDR/DD/TDR to be uploaded online.

- d) Allotment letters of Govt. departments/institutions/PSUs/Reputed Private Business houses for each work in support of the Pre-qualification criteria.

- **3.3** The financial bids of technically qualified bidders only shall be opened online.

4) **CONSULTANT SERVICES**:

4.1 Details of Services

- 4.1.1 To provide conceptual drawings and rough cost estimate.
- 4.1.2 Consult with the CUJ to ascertain their comments and shall finalise the drawings accordingly meeting the guidelines set by Government of India.
- 4.1.4 a) To co-ordinate with the CUJ to facilitate submission of all services drawings and documents sufficient to call for tenders.
 - b) To submit to the CUJ a detailed estimate for the Construction Cost of the building(s).
- 4.1.5 To assist CUJ/CPWD/or any other executing agency in the preparation of complete tender document along with details of specifications for the purpose of inviting tenders and in the evaluation of the bids received.
- 4.1.6 To prepare all drawings and assist the Client in filing the required documents for approval of the statutory authorities having Jurisdiction over the project. All plan submission fees and other costs shall be borne by the CUJ.
- 4.1.7 To provide detailed Architectural drawings, duly vetted Structural drawings and working drawings of all other services with specifications as mentioned in the scope of work after discussions with CUJ and to the entire satisfaction of the CUJ.
- 4.1.8 To provide the schematic interior layouts including design and selection of partition systems, ceilings, floorings, furniture, fabrics, fittings, art works, colour schemes, wall & floor coverings and integration of interior with building system etc.
- 4.1.9 To prepare site plan, site development plan and details of landscape including horticulture & arboriculture.
- 4.1.10 Consultant shall at all times have access to the work whether it is in preparation or progress.

- 4.1.11 The Architect shall pay periodic visits to the worksite as per requirement and / or demand of CUI.
- 4.1.12 On the basis of on-site observations as a Consultant, he shall look into the architectural defects and deficiencies in the work of Consultant. The record of the site meeting will be recorded in Minutes of Meeting and signed by the representatives of CUJ, Consultant, Consultants and others present at site.
- 4.1.13 The Consultant may advise CUJ to reject the work which does not conform to the contract documents/specifications specified. Whenever, in reasonable opinion, he considers it necessary or advisable he will have the authority of special inspection or testing of any work in accordance with the provisions of contract document whether or not such work is fabricated, installed or completed.
- 4.1.14 Consultant shall review shop drawing samples and other submissions of the Consultant for conformance with design concept of the project.
- 4.1.15 Consultant shall issue necessary clarifications, detail drawings, revisions etc. those may be required for smooth progress of work at site.
- 4.1.16 Consultant shall represent CUJ at all the forums where ever required. His out station visit charges shall be borne by CUJ.
- 4.1.17 Consultant is required to make power point presentations and display of drawings at the required forum.
- 4.1.18 To plan, design and suggest methodology for geotechnical Investigation of Project and to provide test borings, test pits, soil bearing values, percolation tests, air and water pollution tests, ground corrosion and resistivity tests and other necessary operation for determining subsoil, air and water condition with appropriate professional interpretation thereof.
- 4.1.19 Consultant cannot further sub-let the allotted job to any other firm/individual/group of individuals.

4.2 ADDITIONAL SERVICES

If any of the following additional services are authorized by the CUJ, they shall be paid for by the CUJ on mutually agreed terms & shall be performed after prior written approval:-

- 4.2.1 Providing service in respect of existing structures or facilities or to make measured drawings thereof, or to verify the accuracy of drawing or other information furnished by the CUJ.
- 4.2.2 Marking major revisions in drawings, specification or other documents when such revisions are inconsistent with written approvals or instructions previously given and are due to causes beyond the control of the Consultant.
- 4.2.3 Making investigations involving detailed appraisals and valuation of existing facilities and surveys and inventories required in connection with construction performed by the CUJ.
- 4.2.4 Providing services of professional consultants for services other than the services detailed herein before.
- 4.2.5 Cost of presentation models, computer simulation, 3D animated videos, BIM etc

4.3 OWNERSHIP OF DRAWINGS

- 4.3.1 Drawings and specifications as instruments of service shall remain the property of the CUJ whether the project for which they are made is executed or not.
- 4.3.2 The Consultant shall not use these designs, drawings, specifications etc. made for the CUJ for any other project and assignment without prior written consent from CUJ.
- 4.3.3 The Consultant will make available six set of Drawings to CUJ in A-2 size including soft copy. It will maintain the records of the Drawings given to CUJ and make it available to CUJ or CUJ's representative as and when required by them. Consultant will also keep a master copy of all the issued drawings.

5) THE CUJ'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 5.1 The CUJ shall provide the full information regarding requirement for the project.
- 5.2 The CUJ shall designate, when necessary, a representative authorized to act on its behalf with respect to the project. The CUJ or his representative shall examine documents submitted by the Consultant and shall liaise with CUJ's competent authority to avoid unreasonable delay in the progress of the Consultant's work.
- 5.3 The CUJ shall furnish, if required a certified land survey of the site giving, as applicable, grades and lines of streets, alleys, pavements and adjoining property, rights of ways, restrictions, easement, encroachment, zoning, deed restriction easements, boundaries and contours of the site, locations, dimensions and complete data pertaining to existing

- building, other improvements and tress; and full information concerning available services and utility lines both public and private, above and below grade, including inverts and depth, if such information is available with CUJ.
- 5.4 The CUJ shall furnish if available, the structural, mechanical, chemical and other laboratory tests, inspections and reports as required by the laws or the contract Documents.
- 5.5 The CUJ shall furnish information required by the consultant expeditiously as necessary for the orderly progress of work, if such information is available with CUJ.

6) PAYMENTS TO THE CONSULTANT

- 6.1 Total Architect fee to be paid to the Consultant shall be quoted as %age of the actual total cost of the project inclusive of all taxes but excluding GOODS AND SERVICE TAX.
 - The GOODS AND SERVICE TAX shall be paid by CUJ separately over and above the Professional fee as per the norms.
- 6.1.1 The quoted fee of the Consultant shall remain same throughout the period of engagement

The fee payable to the Architect shall be computed on the actual total cost of work on completion.

The payment due to the Architect at different stages be computed on the following basis:

- 1) At Stage 1 to 2 C : On rough estimate of cost.
- 2) At Stages 3 to 4 : On preliminary estimate of cost.
- 3) At Stage 5 : On accepted tender cost.4) At Stage 6 : On actual total cost.
- 6.2.1 Consultant payments will be subject to deduction of income tax and other applicable taxes at source as applicable and other statutory provisions.
- 6.2.2 No deduction shall be made from Architect's fee on account of job penalty, liquidated damages or other sums to be withheld from payments to Consultants.

- 6.2.3 The CUJ shall be bound to make payment for the services rendered by the consultant. For the services not required or sought by CUJ from the Consultant, no payment shall be made for the same against the above relevant stages.
- 6.2.4 The Retention Money @ 10% of the fee payable shall be retained by CUJ to be returned to the consultant without interest, after successful completion/execution of the assignment for each individual work. Any recoveries towards delay, Liquidated damages and breach of contract conditions shall be affected from the Retention money.
- 6.2.5 The Architect shall, in consultation with the CUJ, prepare a Time Schedule in respect of various services to be rendered and discharge of CUJ obligations.

7) EFFECTING PAYMENTS TO THE CONSULTANT:

- 7.1 Progressive, on account payments shall be made by the CUJ to the Consultant strictly as per the payment stages shown in clause 6.2 above.
- 7.2 The actual cost of the completed/executed work shall include cost of execution of assigned works referred to in the scope of work and also includes the cost of equipment and machinery such as transformer, DG sets, Substation, Lifts, Air conditioning Machines Pumps & Motors, Water and Sewerage Treatment Plant etc., but excluding the cost of land, furniture and fixtures & fittings.

8) **EXECUTION OF THE ASSIGNMENT:**

- 8.1 All the stages of the work shall be completed by Consultant and the necessary approval given by the CUJ according to the time schedule mutually agreed upon. The work throughout the stipulated period of contract will be carried out with diligence, time being the essence of contract.
- 8.2 In the event of the Consultant's firm closing its business or if the performance of the consultant is not found to the satisfaction of the CUJ even after giving sufficient warnings (maximum three) to improve the performance, the CUJ shall have the option to terminate the contract and employ any other agency to complete the balance work at the risk and cost of the consultant. The securities available with CUJ shall stand forfeited in such case.
- 8.3 The Consultant must have the written permission of CUJ before initiating any stage of his duties.
- 8.4 The Consultant shall assume full responsibility for the design and specifications for the items described in the scope of work. The CUJ will have full access to the details of the

calculation and the structural design for the purpose of the scrutiny for satisfying themselves as to their correctness. The structural engineers of the Consultant will render all possible help for the above scrutiny.

- 8.5 Upon the completion of work, the Consultant will prepare and submit six set of Drawings to CUJ in A-2 size including soft copy of the buildings and services.
- 8.6 The Consultant shall advise CUJ regarding the work under execution during visits to the sites and submit periodic report on observations.
- 8.7 The Consultant shall not make any deviation, alteration or omission from the approved drawing involving financial implication without prior consent of CUJ.
- 8.8 The CUJ shall have the liberty to postpone or not to execute any work and the Consultant shall not be entitled to any compensation for non execution of work in it's entirety except the fees which are payable to the Consultant up to stage of services then in progress.
- 8.9 All the Good for construction drawings (Architectural, Structural, Electrical, Plumbing, Sewerage and Waste Water, HVAC, External Development including drainage) should be available to CUJ before issuing work Order to Successful Consultant.

9) PERFORMANCE SECURITY, LIQUIDATED DAMAGES AND PENALTIES

9.1 Performance Security

- **9.1.1** The consultant shall furnish the Performance Security @ 3% of the agreement value in the form of bank guarantee, within a period of ten days after issue of Letter of Allotment. This performance security shall be pledged to I/c Finance officer, CUJ.
- **9.1.2** This Performance Security shall be appropriated against breach of this agreement or for recovery of liquidated damages as specified in clause 9.2 herein, if any, after exhausting the retention money. The balance amount remaining out of the performance security shall be returned to the consultant.

9.2 Liquidated Damages

9.2.1 Liquidated Damages for error/variation

In case any error or variation is detected in the reports submitted by the Consultant and such errors or variation is the result of negligence on the part of Consultant, the consequential damages thereof shall be quantified by the authority in a reasonable manner and recovered

from the Consultant by way of deemed liquidated damages, subject to maximum of 10% of the Agreement value.

9.2.2 Liquidated damages for delay

In case of delay in completion of services, liquidated damages not exceeding an amount equal to 0.50% of the agreement value per week, subject to a maximum of 10% of the agreement value will be imposed and shall be recovered by appropriation from performance security or otherwise. However, in case of delay due to reasons beyond the control of Consultant, suitable extension of time shall be granted.

For continued delay in rendering satisfactory services by the consultant for the reasons attributable to the consultant, the contract shall become liable for termination at the risk & cost of the firm.

9.2.3 Encashment and appropriation of Performance security

The authority shall have the right to invoke and appropriate the proceeds of the Performance Security, in whole or in part, without notice to the Consultant in the event of breach of this agreement or for recovery of liquidated damages specified in clause 9.2.

10) A) DISPUTE REDRESSAL SYSTEM

10.1 If any dispute or difference of any kind what-so-ever shall arise in connection with or arising out of this contract or the execution of works or maintenance of the works there under whether before its commencement or during the progress of Works or after the termination/abandonment or breach of the contract, it shall in the first instance be referred for settlement to the competent authority i.e. Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu.

The competent authority shall, within a period of forty-five days after being requested in writing by the Consultant to do so, convey his decision to the Consultant in respect of every matter so referred. In case the work is already in progress, the Consultant shall proceed with the execution of the work, including maintenance thereof, pending receipt of the decision of the competent authority as aforesaid, with all due diligence. The decision of the competence authority shall be final & binding on both the parties.

B. PROCEDURE FOR RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES.

10.2The Competent Authority mentioned in Clause 10.1 shall give a decision in writing within 45 days of receipt of a notification of dispute by adopting any procedure/process as deem fit by such authority. However, the competent authority

can extend the said time limit of 45 days as deem fit in deciding the referred dispute with due intimation to both the parties.

10.3 In the event of any dispute or difference if arises, what so ever will be settled down amicably by negotiations. If any dispute which cannot be resolved by negotiation either party may refer the claims/dispute to be settled through the province of J&K Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996, through an arbitrator .The Sole Arbitrator shall be any officer of university whose name is approved by Vice Chancellor and decision of such arbitrator shall be binding upon both the parties subject to Jurisdiction of courts within Jammu only.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this EOI (execution whereof has been approved by the Competent Authorities on the day, month and year first above mentioned at CUJ, Samba.

10.4 Performance of Consultants under the contract shall continue even after reference to the dispute resolution authority and payments due to the Consultant by the employer shall not be withheld unless they are the subject matter of the referred disputes.

11) GOVERNING LAW

Unless otherwise specified, this EOI shall be governed by the law of Union Govt. of India and jurisdiction of the courts of Jammu only

12) The headings of the articles used in the agreement are inserted for convenience of reference only and shall not affect the interpretation of the respective articles of this agreement.

13.0 TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT:

- 13.1 Agreement between the Architect and the Client may be terminated by either one giving the other a written notice of not less than 30 (thirty) days, should either fail substantially to perform his part of responsibilities/duties, so long as the failure is not caused by the one initiating the termination.
- 13.2 When termination of this Agreement is not related or attributable, directly or indirectly to any act, omission, neglect or default on the part of the Architect, the Architect shall be entitled to professional fees for the certified work done up to relevant stage as stipulated under Clause 6.
- 13.3 In the event of Architect's firm closing its business or the Client having terminated the agreement, the Client shall have the right to employ another Architect to complete the work, by entering into new agreement and clear all payments of the previous architect firm.
