Minutes of the Meeting

The meeting of First Board of Studies (BoS) of MBA (Supply Chain Management) was held on 3rd September, 2016 and was convened in the Conference Hall, TAB Sainik Colony, Jammu at 11:00 am onwards.

The meeting starting with a Welcome to all the Members by the Head followed by a brief introduction of the members.

The following issues were discussed and resolved:

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Item-1: Scheme for MBA (Supply Chain Management) Semester-I, II, III & IV.

i. the compiled Scheme for MBA (Supply Chain Management) Semester-I, II, III & IV was presented before the Board Members and the approved Scheme for Semester-I & II only as per Annexure–I (duly signed by all the members).

Item-2: Syllabus of MBA (Supply Chain Management) Semester-I & II.

i. the compiled Syllabus for MBA (Supply Chain Management) was presented before the Board members and the approved Syllabus is as per Annexure – II.

Item-3: Issues related to Examination Pattern for MBA (Supply Chain Management).

- the Present Structure being practiced in other departments of the School was presented before the Board Members and it was resolved the MST question paper should be open ended that is the faculty concerned should be given the liberty to set the paper as per their convenience and as per subject requirement;
- ii. however, the Members were of the view that the proposed pattern for End Term Examination should be as per Annexure-III.
- iii. Moreover, the members were of the opinion that the proposed patterns be adopted only after taking into account the norms of the university in this regard;
- iv. the members authorized the Head to take account of the implications in adoption of the new Pattern and likewise take decision in this regard.

Item-4: Issues Related to Industry-Academia Interface.

- i. the Members were briefed about the proposed Partnership between Safeducate and Central University of Jammu for the course;
- ii. the members were of the strong opinion that such an initiative would help strengthen the Industry-Academia Interface / Link, hence, the Department should move ahead for signing MoU between CUJ and Safeducate.;
- iii. the Members were also briefed about the 36 hours Industry Orientation Workshop that has also been included in the Scheme of the course and has been proposed for each of the four Semesters of the course;
- iv. the Members were again of the opinion that these Workshops of 36 hours in each Semester would help students acquire the desired Skills for the Industry and hence such an initiative would improve students employability options in the future;
- v. the Members furthermore resolved that the Contents for the proposed 36 hours Workshop should be acquired for each of the Semesters from the proposed Industry / Knowledge Partner (Safeducate) and authorized the Head to deliberate upon the same prior to its conduct;

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Item-5: Issues related to hiring of services of professional for TALLY Course.

- i. the Members resolved and approved that the services of a local Chartered Accountant (C.A.) be utilized for teaching the course of TALLY, as such a course would enable students to practice the business accounts more efficiently:
- ii. the members approved the CV of the C.A. as per Annexure-IV;
- iii. however the Members also resolved and authorized that in case the approved C.A. as per Annexure-IV is unavailable, Head should arrange for hiring the services of any other C.A.;
- iv. the Members further resolved that the number of lectures to be allotted to the C.A. be as per course requirement and emoluments as per University / UGC norms.

Item-6: Miscellaneous issues related to the smooth conduct of the aforesaid course.

- i. the Members authorized Head to prepare the list of Paper Setters for End Term Examination for Sem-I & II;
- ii. the Members were of the strong opinion that at least one (01) Industrial Visit should be conducted for the students in each Semester and in this regard the support of the proposed Industry Partner be soughed out;
- iii. the Members authorized Head to make any minor changes in the Scheme / Syllabus if required with a condition that these changes be intimated to the Members and get the same vetted thru circulation via email through the Members.
- iv. The Issue of Interdisciplinary Course for Undergraduate Programme was raised before the Board Members and the Subjects that were approved for the same are as per Annexure-V. Moreover, the members resolved and authorized the Head to prepare the Syllabus for the aforesaid courses and get the same vetted by the Members via circulation

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The meeting ended with a positive note.




