## Learning Material

The National Policy on Disaster Management (NPDM), 2009, approved by the Government of India, aims to build a disaster-resilient nation by developing a proactive, multi-disaster oriented, and technology-driven strategy. Developed in line with the Disaster Management Act of 2005, it focuses on prevention, mitigation, preparedness, and rehabilitation.

### Key Aspects of the 2009 Policy:

- **Institutional Framework:** Establishes the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) headed by the Prime Minister, along with State (SDMA) and District (DDMA) authorities to ensure a coordinated response.
- **Proactive Approach:** Shifts from a relief-centric approach to a proactive, holistic strategy focusing on mitigation and preparedness.
- **Community Involvement:** Emphasizes community-based disaster management, capacity building, and strengthening local resilience.
- **Key Focus Areas:** Covers rehabilitation, reconstruction, and technology-driven disaster management, incorporating lessons from past events.
- **Targeted Safety:** Highlights the need for structural safety in school buildings and structural/non-structural mitigation measures, particularly for vulnerable groups.

The policy provides a comprehensive roadmap for central, state, and district stakeholders to handle emergencies effectively.
