# Hostel & Accommodation – FAQ for PG Admissions 2025–26 Central University of Jammu

## 1. Is hostel accommodation available for PG students?

Yes, hostel accommodation is available for both male and female PG students, subject to availability and on a first-come, first-served basis.

## 2. How can I apply for hostel accommodation?

Once you are admitted to a PG programme, you will receive a separate notification or application form for hostel allotment through the university portal.

#### 3. What are the hostel fees?

The detailed hostel fee structure is:

- 1. Rs. 18000/semester for on Campus per semester
- 2. Rs. 12000/ semester for off Campus per semester

It generally includes:

- Hostel seat rent is per semester.
- Electricity & water charges
- Caution money (refundable)

## 4. Is the mess facility available in the hostels?

Yes, mess facilities are provided in the hostels. The mess charges are paid separately by the students.

## 5. What is included in the hostel accommodation?

The hostel generally provides:

- A bed, study table, chair, and cupboard
- Common washrooms
- Wi-Fi access
- Common room or recreation area
- Basic security and housekeeping

## 6. Are hostel facilities available for all PG programmes?

Hostel facilities are extended to students of all full-time PG programmes. Priority is usually given to students from distant locations or economically weaker sections.

#### 7. What is the duration of hostel allotment?

Hostel allotment is usually for one academic year and is renewable based on discipline, academic performance, and availability.

## 8. Are there any restrictions or rules for hostel residents?

Yes, students must follow the **hostel rules and regulations** laid down by the university, which include guidelines on attendance, visitors, mess timings, and quiet hours.

# 9. Is there a separate hostel for girls?

Yes, the university provides separate hostels for male and female students, each with appropriate security measures.

10. Whom can I contact for hostel-related queries?
You may contact the Hostel Warden. Contact details will be available on the university website or your admission brochure.
